- Fasten all gates and leave property as you find it or follow instructions on signs.
- Keep to public paths across farmland.
- Use gates and stiles to cross fences, hedges, and walls.
- Leave crops and machinery alone.
- Give wild animals, livestock, and horses plenty of space. Their behaviour can be unpredictable, especially when with their young and you could get hurt.
- Do not feed livestock, horses, or wild animals as it can cause them harm and create nuisance for other walkers who use the path later.
- Take your litter home.
- Protect wildlife, plants, and trees.
- Help to keep water clean.
- Take special care on country roads.
- Guard against all risk of fire.
- Keep your dogs under close control. (Coventry CHA do not allow dogs on our walks)
- Make no unnecessary noise.
- Enjoy the countryside and respect its life and work.
